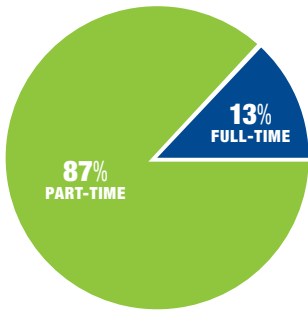
ADULT BASIC EDUCATION STUDENTS

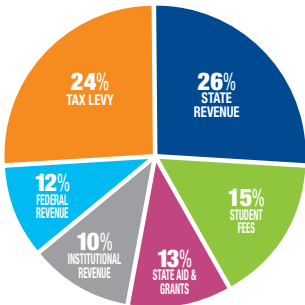

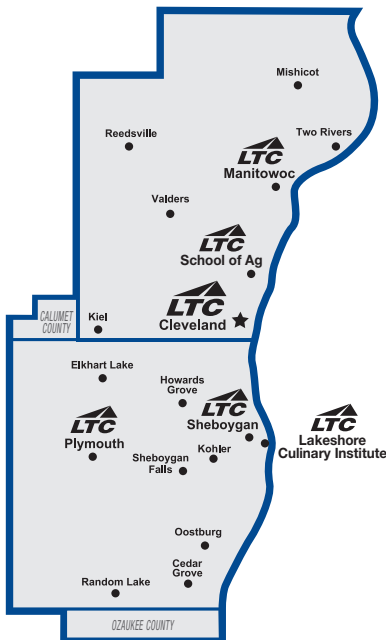
