

# Designated Smoking Shelters/Areas

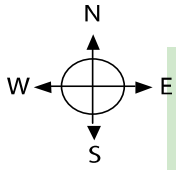
Over the last year, the Student Government Association worked collaboratively with college leadership to implement necessary steps to clarify the Tobacco/Smoke-Free college policy. These steps included the following:

- Stronger campus police enforcement of current smoking policy
- Modify and better define designated smoking areas/shelters

These steps were reviewed and completed through a team that included campus police, college leadership, SGA representatives, and other interested students. Effective January 2, 2012, smoking will be allowed only within the confines of the smoking shelters/designated area (see map on next page) or in your personal vehicle. This means that smoking outside of your vehicle in the parking lots, along the pathways, or in a non-designated area would be in violation of the policy and you could be subject to the student conduct code (LTC Student Handbook, p. 145).

# Designated Smoking Shelters/Areas



The star ★ indicates the designated smoking areas. Smoking is only allowed in these areas.

- Public Safety Bldg** – east outdoor shelter
- Lakeshore Bldg** – lower southwest corner outdoor shelter and northeast outdoor shelter
- Trade & Industry Bldg** – northeast outdoor shelter
- Agriculture/Energy Bldg** – southwest outdoor area
- Flexible Training Arena** – northeast outdoor area
- Environmental Campus** – southwest outdoor area
