Policy Statement		
<p>The Tobacco-Smoke Free Campus policy is part of the college’s commitment to creating a healthy campus for all members of our campus community, and is designed to be positive and supportive of overall health and well-being.</p> <p>The Tobacco-Smoke Free Campus policy defines tobacco, smoking, or vapor products as including but not limited to all tobacco products including cigarettes, cigars, pipes, any devices used to smoke tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, vaporizers that are alternatives to smoking products, water pipes, smokeless tobacco products such as, chewing or dipping products, etc.</p> <p>The use of tobacco, smoking, and vapor products is prohibited in all buildings and grounds owned or leased by Lakeshore Technical College. Individuals may use these products in their personal vehicles; however, improper disposal or littering of cigarette butts, smoking, or tobacco materials on campus grounds is prohibited.</p> <p>Enforcement of the policy will be achieved primarily through respectful communication of the policy, education, and awareness.</p>
