<b>Policy Statement</b>		
<p><u>Exclusion for Health Reasons</u></p> <p>Where because of health reasons a student may require individual care or attention by school personnel above what is normally required, and where such health conflict causes serious interruption of the learning process, the Student Services manager may appoint a committee of professional personnel, including those who possess direct knowledge of the situation, to consider exclusion of such student for health reasons.</p> <p>If dismissal is a probability, the student will be so informed and will be invited to discuss the matter with the committee.</p> <p>The committee may recommend dismissal action. If such recommendation is made, the Student Services manager will serve notice on the student of such discussion. Upon request, a hearing may be provided before a Lakeshore Technical College administrative official or officials.</p>
