<b>Policy Statement</b>		
<p>Committed to the protection of its students, its campus community, and the general public, Lakeshore Technical College mandates compliance with the Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act of 2000. The law, which amends the Jacob Wetterling Crimes Against Children and Sexually violent Offenders Registration Act, requires individuals convicted of sexually violent offenses or offenses involving the sexual abuse of exploitation of minors, to register current addresses.
