Orders can be shipped to your home for an additional fee. Caps, gowns, and tassels can be picked up from the LTC Bookstore beginning May 2.

Honors

If your program GPA is 3.500 or higher, you'll be recognized as an Honors graduate. Graduates receiving Presidential Honors (4.0 GPA) receive a special medallion to showcase this great achievement. Honors graduates (3.5-3.99 GPA) receive an honor cord. Honor medallions and honor cords will be distributed at the celebration on campus. If you are a member of Phi Theta Kappa Beta Lambda Sigma, watch your LTC email for details about purchasing a gold honor stole.

In recognition of military service to the United States of America, students who are honorably discharged U.S. Veterans, are currently serving in the U.S. military (active duty, National Guard, or Reserves), or will be commissioned upon graduation, are given the opportunity to receive a red, white, and blue honor cord.
