

May 2022 GED/HSED Graduation Celebration FAQ's

Graduation Celebration

Q: What type of graduation celebration is LTC having for the May 2022 graduation?

A: Graduates will have the opportunity to have their name and credential announced, walk across stage and receive your diploma cover. Celebrate achievements with family and friends and enjoy refreshments after.

Q: How long will it last?

A: The conferring of credentials will only take a few minutes. You may spend as much time as you like on campus celebrating. Buildings will be open until 2:30pm.

Q: Where will the celebration be held?

A: The celebration will take place in Centennial Hall located in the Lakeshore Building on the LTC-Cleveland campus. Signs will be posted and staff will be on hand to direct you.

Q: Where do I check in?


A: When you arrive on campus check in will be in room **L-109** in the Lakeshore Building. Please check in before going to Centennial Hall. After checking in you will line up in the hallway by the Fitness Center. Staff will be on hand to assist you.

Q: What time do I need to be there?

A: GED/HSED graduates will receive their robes and prepare to walk across the stage starting at 12:30pm. Please plan to arrive no later than 12:45pm to walk with friends and peers. The scheduled time for the GED/HSED celebration starts at 1:00pm and lasts until 1:30pm.

Q: Do I get my diploma at the graduation celebration?

A: No. You will receive your diploma cover, but the actual diploma will be mailed to you from the Department of Public Instruction. You may have already received your diploma, but please plan to celebrate your graduation accomplishments at LTC!



Caps and Gowns

Q: Will I need a cap and gown for the graduation celebration?

A: LTC provides a cap and gown to use during the celebration. As you check in at room **L-109**, you will receive a cap and gown. Then, after the celebration, before you leave campus, please return it at that same location. There is no need to pre-order. We will have what you need to be ready for your day.

Guests

Q: Can family and friends attend the celebration?

A: Yes! There is no limit to the number of guests you can bring.

Q: Do I need tickets?

A: No, tickets are not required.

Miscellaneous

Q: Where do I park?

A: Graduates and guests should park in Parking Lot 1, cross the covered wooden bridge, and enter at door L3. See campus map. Accessible parking is available in all lots with a permit.

Q: Can I take pictures?

A: Yes, guests can approach the stage and take pictures of the graduates. Staff will be near the stage to take a photo of you. There will also be selfie stations and other backdrops around campus. Photos will be posted to LTC's social media pages where you will have the opportunity to download them.

Q: Will the ceremony be live streamed?

A: Yes. You can view the ceremony via LTC's YouTube channel.

Q: Do I have to wear a mask?

A: Masks are optional. LTC remains sensitive to the pandemic, and follows multiple sanitary protocols to mitigate the associated risks to anyone on the campuses.

Q: Should I dress up?

A: Graduates typically wear a cap and gown. Guests can dress in casual attire.

Q: What if myself or a family member need an accommodation?

A: If you or a family member need assistance getting in the building, please contact our College Health Nurse at 920-693-1111. Elevators and accessible doors are available. Weather permitting, a golf cart providing rides from the parking lot to the building will be available.

Q: Will the Bookstore be open?

A: Yes. The Bookstore will be open from 8:30am-1:30pm for any graduates or guests that would like to purchase some LTC merchandise.
