Graduation Ceremony

- Virtual ceremony is May 22 beginning at 9am on our Facebook page and our Lakeshore Technical College YouTube channel.
- Drive through ceremony by division will be offered after the virtual ceremony outside or in the auto maintenance shop if there is inclement weather.

Important Dates

- May 10 Caps and gowns available for pickup in the Bookstore.

Honors recognition

- To be eligible for Honors a program grade point average of 3.500 to 3.999 is required. Honors graduates will receive a medallion with a white ribbon.
- To be eligible for Presidential Honors a program grade point average of 4.000 is required. Presidential Honors graduates will receive an honor cord.

- You will receive your medallion or cord at check-in during the drive through ceremony or when you pick up your cap/gown from the bookstore. You can also pick up your medallion/cord at the Student Services Welcome Center any time after graduation.
- PTK members watch your email for details about purchasing a gold honor stoles.
- In recognition of military service to the United States of America, students who are honorably discharged U.S. veterans, are currently serving in the U.S. military (active duty, National Guard, or Reserves), or will be commissioned upon graduation, are given the opportunity to receive a red, white, and blue honor cord. Contact Student Records if you would like to receive a cord.
