As part of our accreditation process, LTC wishes to disclose the following programmatic information for the previous three-years of program and student performance:

NR Written Success is defined as the percentage of program graduates that pass the National Registry of EMTs Paramedic written examination within the allowed attempts.

Retention is defined as the percentage of students that enter the program divided by the number of students that successfully complete the program coursework.

Positive Placement is defined as the percentage of program graduates, surveyed between 6 and 12 months post-graduation that report being employed as paramedics. This information is only able to reflect those graduates that do return the survey information.
