

CPR AND FIRST AID CERTIFICATION

The CPR and First-Aid certifications require taking two separate classes. Below are options to obtain the proper classes:

CPR

1. **Through Lakeshore Technical College**
Basic Life Support (BLS) Health Care Provider is the CPR class offered by LTC. This class is four hours long and usually run each month. Check at the Registration Desk for availability or search online by catalog number 42531419.
2. **Through American Red Cross (NOT FOR SHEBOYGAN AREA MEDICAL ASSISTANT STUDENTS)**
CPR for the Professional Rescuer is the class offered by your local chapter of the American Red Cross that meets our requirements. However, students in the Medical Assistant program planning to do clinical in the Sheboygan Area should avoid this class as there is a clinical site that will not accept it. These classes usually run on a monthly basis. **Please note that you may need to ask them to add the AED component for an additional fee.**
3. **Through Other Organizations**
Several organizations offer CPR classes. It is your responsibility to make sure they meet the following requirements: 1-person, 2-person, infant, child, adult, and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) training. **Sheboygan Area Medical Assistant students will want to make sure the CPR is American Heart Association provided.**

First Aid

1. **Through Lakeshore Technical College**
First Aid classes are usually 3 hours in length and run a few weeks prior to each semester start. Check at the Registration Desk for availability or search online by catalog number 42531470.
2. **Through American Red Cross or Other Organizations**
Check with other providers as to class dates, times, and availability.
