Need to fill a job opening or an internship? Post it on Wisconsin TechConnect, a free, online service provided to employers to recruit graduates and students from the 16 colleges in the Wisconsin Technical College System. Employers have the ability to post jobs and internships and access student resumes which are matched to the postings. Once the posting is approved, email notifications are sent to students, graduates and faculty to promote the opening quickly and efficiently.
