

Disc Golf Course Rules

Welcome to the LTC Cleveland Campus Disc Golf Course. We take great pride in our naturally beautiful setting, and are happy to share it with our Disc Golf friends. While you enjoy your challenging round of disc golf through our naturally rustic setting we ask that you follow a few rules.

Alcohol: LTC Cleveland Campus is alcohol free. Alcohol is strictly forbidden on or in our buildings/grounds.

COURSE HOURS: The course is open for play during the daylight hours only.

TRASH: Keeping these grounds in pristine condition takes great effort and we ask for your help in keeping this course in top shape. You are responsible for policing your own trash; if you bring it, please take it with you. If you notice areas of the Disc Golf course which need attention for repair or clean up, please call LTC's Physical Plant at 920-693-1617.

PETS: Leashed pets are allowed on course. You are responsible for cleanup. You don't clean up, this privilege will be eliminated.

The LTC Campus and surrounding grounds are routinely patrolled by LTC Campus Police and Security for your safety and security. Violations of these rules observed by or reported to them may result in enforcement action being taken.

GENERAL	Disc Golf is played like ball golf using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The object is to acquire the lowest score.
TEE THROWS	Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area.
LIE	The spot on or directly underneath the spot where the previous throw landed.
THROWING ORDER	After teeing-off, the player whose disc is farthest from always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee-off on the nest hole.
FAIRWAY THROWS	Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed.
DOG LEG	A dog leg is one or more designated trees or poles in the fairway that must be passed on the outside when approaching the hole. Until the dog leg is passed, the closed foot to the dog leg must be on the lie when the disc is released.
PUTT THROW	Within 3 meters of the pole, a player may not step past the point of his lie in making his putt throw. Failing or jumping putts are not allowed.
COMPLETION OF HOLE	A disc that comes to rest in the Disc Pole Hole basket constitutes successful completion of that hole.
UNPLAYABLE LIE	Any disc that comes to rest more than 2 meters above the ground is considered an unplayable lie. The disc must be thrown from the new lie on the ground, directly underneath the unplayable lie. (1 throw penalty)
OUT OF BOUNDS	A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from the point where the disc went out of bounds. Water hazards and public roads are always out of bounds. (1 throw penalty)
COURSE COURTESY	Don't throw until the players ahead of you are out of range.
