- 2. In the last ten days, eighteen (18) students requested an emergency grant. If you have previously donated to the LTC Foundation you can un-restrict your gift to support these grants. But you, as the donor, can un-restrict those funds to be used instead for student emergency grants (assuming funds are still left). This is exactly what I did. So did my dad.
