College Update: Polly Abts, LTC VP of Student Services emphasized the importance of student's voices and how they can express their opinions (surveys, focus groups, etc.); discussed Open Educational Resources (OER); referenced the Fall 2020 HVAC Program and discussed the new location of the bookstore.

2019-20 SGA Budget Overview and Request for Approval: The purpose of the 2019-2020 Budget is provide student enrichment and development opportunities as well as to instill responsibility and accountability. The budget this academic year will fund the following:

- Health/Wellness (Equipment, Flu Shots, etc.)
- Special Student Events (Orientation, Awards Reception, etc.)
- Graduation
- Student Government Association Specific Activities
 - Student Activities and Entertainment
 - Student Organization Assistance
 - o Travel Grants
 - Leadership and Development Workshops
 - Student Handbook/Planners
 - LTC EXPRESS Transit Service
 - Printing/Supplies for Events
- Staffing
- Email, Lab Supplies, and Web Access

The proposed LTC SGA Budget estimates \$375,000 in revenue and \$369,100 in expenditures which would result in a \$5,900 remaining balance for future years' use or unexpected needs throughout the academic year. Austin Monka (Weld club) motioned to approve the LTC SGA Budget as presented; Andrew Dunbar (Lakeshore Culinary Association International), seconded. The 2019-2020 LTC SGA Budget Proposal was unanimously approved.
