

## PROPOSED RESTRUCTURE OF LTC STUDENT LEADERSHIP

**2020-2021 Replace Current 3-Student Officer Election to Expand Student Leadership Opportunities:** Create 9 LTC SLB member positions to be filled by application process:

- 7 educational division (programs) positions; minimum 5 must be filled in spring term current year for upcoming year:
  - Agriculture
  - Business & Technology
  - Energy
  - Health & Human Services
  - Manufacturing
  - Public Safety
  - Transportation
- 2 at-large positions (any program); filled in fall term upcoming year
- If any educational division positions are unfilled in spring, they may be filled in fall term upcoming year
- Executive Staff Advisors (Director of Student Resources and Student Engagement Specialist; appointed by college; provide guidance, development and support; non-voting)

The LTC SLB student members will identify Chair, Co-Chair and Treasurer officers from within this group using a simple nomination/voting process (self- or by another student board member). **Chair, Co-Chair and Treasurer** will be responsible for conducting all official meetings (full board and student organization reps) and working meetings (board, executive advisors, others as needed). **Board members, along with Chair, Co-Chair, Treasurer**, are responsible for attending official/working meetings, participating in college student forums seeking student input/feedback, LTC SLB annual budget review, student events input. **A minimum of two board members are responsible for representing LTC SLB within the Wisconsin Student Government organization.**

- **LTC SLB Member Eligibility Requirements:**
  - Educational division members: Enrolled in minimum 6 credits/term for upcoming academic year; must attend official meetings/events
  - At-large members: Enrolled in minimum 6 credits/term for upcoming academic year; must attend official meetings/events
  - Must achieve/maintain minimum 2.0 GPA each term
  - Must be free of LTC Student Code of Conduct violations

**LTC SLB Member Performance Incentive Program:** Members are required to attend ALL scheduled official meetings, training sessions, and Learn Lead Succeed conferences; for each required event attended, members will receive a \$25 gift card as an incentive reward.

- 2 board training sessions—June, October
- 4 business meetings—September, November, February, April
- 2 Learn Lead Succeed conferences—fall and spring
- \$200 gift card incentive reward per person
- Eligible to earn Learn Lead Succeed Stand-Out Certificates and/or other awards as applicable

**Future:** Applications available March-April (4 weeks); selections made before April official meeting; same review process

  - President
  - Vice President
  - Secretary-Treasurer
  - Executive Staff Advisors available for guidance
- Communicate results
- Plan and conduct LTC SLB member orientation/training/selection of Chair, Co-chair, Treasurer by June 1
- Unfilled positions apply in fall, in addition to two at-large positions
  - Applications open August 15-September 8
  - LTC SLB members review/select; staff advisors available for guidance
  - Selections made by September 15
  - Onboard new members prior to September official meeting

LTC SGA Member Application: Online to include the following; will need to change slightly for spring/fall to reflect different language for educational division versus at-large positions:

- Name and LTC ID
- Address, Phone, LTC Email
- I certify that I:
  - Will be enrolled in at least 6 associate degree or technical diploma classes in 2020-2021 (spring/fall)
  - Am a returning student with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA
  - Am a new student, currently no cumulative GPA
  - Understand I must achieve/maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA to serve as an LTC SLB member; falling below this minimum cumulative GPA requirement will result in my automatic resignation
  - Have no violations of the LTC Student Code of Conduct within the last two years
  - Understand that violating the LTC Student Code of Conduct will result in automatic resignation
  - Understand that I will be required to attend in-person meetings/events
- Long-Answer Questions (required):
  - Why did you choose LTC? (req)
  - As a member of the LTC SLB, what skills/talents will you share? (req)
  - Being part of a successful board requires effective communication. Describe how you engage in effective communication. (optional, pick 1)
