<b>Policy Statement</b> Treatment of and interaction with students, staff and persons from the community shall not be inhumane, unfair or undignified and will not be in violation of the Wisconsin Code of Ethics for Public Officials and Employees.  Accordingly, the President may not:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Operate without policies and/or procedures which set forth staff and student rules, provide for effective handling of grievances, insure due process, and protect against wrongful actions against or by staff or students.</li><li>2. Fail to comply with all state and federal laws, rules and regulations pertaining to employees and students including those pertaining to discrimination and equal opportunity.</li><li>3. Prevent students and staff from using established grievance procedures.</li><li>4. Fail to acquaint students and staff with their rights and responsibilities.</li><li>5. Fail to take prompt and appropriate action when the President becomes aware of any violation of state or federal laws, rules or regulations or of Board policies.</li></ol>
