<p align="center">Policy Statement</p> <p>Academic Forgiveness is defined as a one-time opportunity to omit the grade point average calculation of credit courses taken during a prior enrollment period at LTC. However, course grades will remain on the student transcript.</p> <p>Financial Aid funding and Satisfactory Academic Progress do not fall under the Academic Forgiveness policy; enrollment/grade history will continue to be a factor when determining financial aid eligibility.</p> <p>Courses counted toward previous degree completion will not qualify under this policy.</p>		
<p align="center">Reason for Policy</p> <p>Academic forgiveness allows returning students with previous academic difficulties an opportunity to refresh their grade point average.</p>
